

iiX MVR Program for Employees with Texas Driver's License

When you call into iiX and talk with Stefanie Haggerty, she will go over all the fees. We cannot publish them here because they may vary based on several factors. However, the process is the same.

To start you will need to set up an account. There is a one time set up fee which has been discounted for 365 Workplace Safety members. You will pay that fee and at the end of the quarter, 365 Workplace Safety will obtain a list of new members with iiX and send each of them a full refund of the set-up fee, up to \$60.00.

If you want the automated monitoring service, where each driver you list is checked daily for activity, you will pay a monthly fee for each driver. The maximum charge is \$1.00 per driver per month.

When you start the automated monitoring process, an MVR will automatically be generated on each driver you enable for monitoring, and you will be charged for those MVR's. Then you pay the monthly monitoring fee until an activity takes place.

If a driver has activity, i.e. something on their record has changed, the system sends you an email and automatically downloads the MVR to your account. There is a charge for this MVR as well.

Each month you get a statement and the charge is just for the cost of the daily monitoring if there is no other activity. If there is activity in a month, then the statement will include the cost of the MVR generated and there is a nominal fee for processing the other charges in the statement.

365 Workplace Safety encourages members to consider the automated process for two very important reasons:

1. If one of your driver's is involved in an accident that leads to the other party obtaining an attorney, the first thing the attorney will do is pull your employee's driving record. If that record shows excessive problems or shows the license is suspended, you, as the employer, will be asked what steps you are taking to keep bad drivers from operating your company vehicles. Having a program that monitors your drivers daily and keeps you informed, would allow your business to act to remove drivers when necessary, and is a wonderful way to show a jury that you have a solid program in place.
2. Once the automated program is in place, you control who is monitored and can add and delete drivers as necessary. Some companies, for example those that are DOT regulated, may still have to pull an annual MVR for each driver. However, if your company does not have that obligation, then you can sit back and enjoy a fully automated monitoring service.
